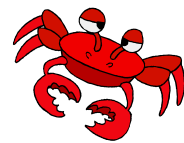

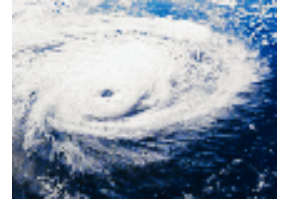

Hurricane Season is Baaack...

Hurricanes and tropical storms are a serious threat for the Chesapeake Bay. In the unfortunate event of a named storm hitting our area and we have to proceed with our Hurricane Haul Out Service, it's critical we have a key to your vessel on hand. We will need a key not only to the lock on your companionway door but to the engine as well. Please drop off a copy of your keys or your combo in the marina office. We will tag and file them for you. If you choose not to have your boat hauled, please note that our policy is all boats to be evacuated from the marina, in the event of a named storm.



Some additional housekeeping notes regarding storm season. Jackson Creek gets hit with heavy winds often during this time of year, we call them squalls and they sometimes pack wind gusts of 50 knots plus. It is vital that we have your current contact information, should we need to contact you regarding your boat. Please send Ed an email with your current cell and home phone numbers, or any way to get in touch with you.

We strongly recommend you have extra lines and fenders accessible in the cockpit area should we need to prevent your boat from strong wind damage. And, per your slip contract, it's required all vessels in our marina are insured, and a copy your policy filed in the marina office. If you haven't already given us a copy, please do so as soon as possible. If you're not sure if we have it on file, call us and we'll check for you.
